China's Foreign Minister Wang Yi condemned U.S. pressure over fentanyl-related issues, vowing that China would "resolutely counter" such actions. He criticized U.S. tariff policies and emphasized that major powers should not exploit weaker nations. Wang also acknowledged China's cooperation with the U.S. in addressing fentanyl precursors but warned against a "two-faced" approach in diplomatic relations. Rising tensions over fentanyl policies risk escalating, potentially deepening diplomatic rifts and complicating future negotiations on trade and international security.

U.S. tariffs on USMCA-compliant goods from Canada and Mexico are expected to remain in place until April 2, providing temporary relief to automakers. However, the U.S. plans to introduce reciprocal tariffs on industries such as automobiles and pharmaceuticals afterward. While the extension offers short-term stability, the impending tariffs could heighten trade tensions, disrupt supply chains, and increase market volatility, particularly in the automotive and pharmaceutical sectors.
